

## Judging Guidelines

If a specific subject is given to photograph does the photo fit the subject given/chosen ?

### Impact

Does it grab your attention ( Look at it for more than one second ! )

Does it excite your imagination ? ( Makes you laugh , cry , sad ? )

Does it show a familiar subject in a new way ?

Does it show an unusual subject in an effective way ?

### Composition

Is the cropping of the subject effective ?

Is the alignment correct? Or is it crooked by intent?

Are there leading lines taking the eye into the photo?

### Technical

**Focus :** Is the image sharp ? Is it intentionally soft ?

**Depth of field:** Is the main subject sharp? Is the background out of focus to make the main subject stand out?

**Density :** Is it too light ? Too dark ? Just right ?

**Lighting :** Is the lighting effective ? Too dark ? Just right ? Do the shadows add to, or detract from the photo?

**Colours :** Does it have a strange colour cast ? If black and white is it too greyish ? Is that intentional ?

**Manipulation :** Obvious signs of bad manipulation such as pixilation ?

**Printing :** Lines or banding caused by blocked printer heads or Running out of ink

### Presentation

**Physical :** Is the print free of finger prints , scratches, creases, dust, spots, stains ?

Paper choice may also play a part in the impact of the photograph.

For judging of a photo ignore the borders it may enhance the photo but it is the photo you are judging.
