When registering, instructions will be given on how to submit the photographs. The photographs must be taken during this week and in Alhaurin el Grande or the surrounding area.

A selection of the best photographs will be displayed at the opening of the Shutterbug's annual exhibition, in the Alhaurin el Grande Casa de la Cultura, at the beginning of November.

The best photographs will be ones that can be identified as Alhaurin el Grande and depicting

some aspect of daily life during that week in September.

The photographers will retain the copyright of the pictures for sale, but by submitting any pictures, they will be agreeing that the Shutterbugs Group and the town hall may use the pictures for any type of display purposes that they see fit. The town hall is considering putting on a slide-show of the selected photographs in the library as well as at the Casa de la Cultura.

It is Shutterbugs' intention to give a copy of the selected photographs to the town hall, to start an archive, and as a record of life as it is in 2014 for future generations to look back on in years to come.
